The sisters have offered us tea and coffee afterwards followed by a gentle tour led by Tom Henry (a friend of the Convent) around some Catholic sites in London and driven back home around 5pm. As a guide, and from one quote we were given, if we have 15 people coming along it will work out around £40 per person. However, nothing is booked at the moment and that could change (to be cheaper) depending on the uptake.
